LAWYER RON stalked the pace, was steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch and again on the turn, angled out for the drive, rallied to take over just inside the eighth pole, then drew clear under a hand ride. ISTAN tracked the pace, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole but was no match for the winner. ECCLESIASTIC chased the pace three wide, made a run to try for the lead racing into the stretch, then tired. B. B. BEST chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the turn, then gave way in the drive. EDENWOLD up close early, faltered. WHOS CRYING NOW rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and faded. HAL'S IMAGE showed speed along the inside to midway of the turn, then had nothing left. SUPERVISOR was not a factor. A. J. MELINI was outrun after being steadied when he tried to bite WHOS CRYING NOW at the start.
