Footnotes

DUKE OF MISCHIEF rated off the pace inside, eased three wide making a bid into the final turn, came out looking for room in midstretch and got up the closing strides. GLITTERMANS CARTEL rated close off the rail, took aim into the lane, dug in gamely for a slim brief lead in deep stretch then outfinished the final strides. HOT ROD TUTT rated a short lead inside, dug in with a slim advantage from the head of the lane but grudgingly yielded the closing yards. KHUKURI rated off the pace inside, lacked room on the rail through the final turn then stayed hemmed in through the length of the stretch. GREAT BELIEF, unhurried inside, finished well. TRIBAL BEAD rated off the pace, came five wide through the final turn then proved empty in the stretch. URBAN LEGEND showed no early speed mid track, angled in entering the stretch then eased back toward mid track to finish evenly. MONASHEE BANDIT was outrun.

TAPITBOUND rated close to the early pace in mid track then weakened through the lane. RAISED WILD and GOLDEN STRIDE were outrun. WILD SHOOTER rated off the pace about the three path, was carried out leaving the quarter pole and gave way from there.
