Footnotes

PAISANO CREEK unhurried early, advanced between horses around the far turn, angled out for room in the stretch and rallied to be up late. NERGAL (FR) reserved racing along the inside, eased out for the stretch run, was caught in traffic in midstretch, found room and rallied between rivals for the place. SARATOGA MATT rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the sixteenth pole but

was outfinished. SUNSHINE KID allowed to settle, raced three wide around the far turn and found his best stride late. JAMALUDIN unhurried early, closed ground late without threatening and finished on even terms with DUG IN. The latter, tracked the pace into the stretch but had no late response. BROADWAY ACTOR set the pace along the rail to the sixteenth pole and gave way. STORM CALLER raced three wide and failed to menace. CENZONTLE tracked the pace along the inside to midstretch, then tired. AUTHORITY RULES was not a factor. JOEY THE SCHOLAR chased the pace to inside the eighth pole, then was faltering when steadied from close quarters.
