SANTA stalked the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, responded when headed at the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner late. KEY TO THE EMPIRE stalked the pace into the stretch but had no late response. HANSON HEIGHTS reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed

with a mild response to just miss the show. WAR COLLEGE set the pace along the rail to the far turn, then gave way. UNIQUE TUNE failed to menace. PAPA DAVE unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and was not a threat. KENNY THE SALESMAN was not a factor. POSITIVE ACTION was outrun. MR. IZZY tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and tired. IN FOR A SONG saved ground and faltered. HALO WEST rated off the pace, saved ground and faded.
