FLY ON THE WALL reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied under pressure to be up late. AIR UNION pressed the pace outside TAX MAN SAM, moved to take over from that rival at the eighth pole, then drifted out inside the sixteenth pole under left-handed urging causing WILD APACHE to clip heels and couldn't resist the winner. TAX MAN SAM set the pace under pressure along the rail into the stretch, then tired. COLLABORATE

chased the pace, angled three wide on the turn to continue chasing the leaders into the stretch, then faltered. PERFECT PROSPECTOR reserved after stumbling at the start, advanced along the inside into the stretch, then was checked late to avoid the spill and failed to recover. SAMMY'S TRIP outrun after breaking slowly, was forced wide by FOGGY MOUNTAIN on the turn, then was not persevered with through the stretch while remaining wide to avoid the fallen riders. FOGGY MOUNTAIN rated off the pace, was racing four wide when he drifted out on the turn and eased in the stretch run. WONWAY STREET showed early foot, faded and was eased in the stretch run. UNIVERSAL SOUL reserved off the pace, was no factor when he stumbled over the fallen WILD APACHE late and unseated his rider. A. P. SIERRA well placed into the stretch, stumbled over the fallen IN THE SWEETS late unseating his rider. IN THE SWEETS unhurried after hesitating at the start, was rallying into contention when he hit the fallen WILD APACHE inside the sixteenth pole and fell. WILD APACHE tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then was rallying when he clipped heels with AIR UNION inside the sixteenth pole and fell. Following a stewards inquiry, AIR UNION was disqualified and placed twelfth.
