BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY tracked the pace, eased in to save ground around the far turn, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be up late. CHARLIES SWELL stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over at the top of the stretch and edged clear but couldn't resist the winner late. PRAETEREO unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals to be up for the show. WHERE'S THE BEEF chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead midway of the far turn, then tired in the drive. PLEASANT RUN failed to menace. HAMMERSMITH rated off the pace after breaking awkwardly, moved up four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faltered in the drive. VOLCANO RUN set the pace along the inside to midway of the far turn, then faded. CLEAR ATTEMPT was not a factor. STORMBERG was through after six furlongs. KATZIMO saved ground and was done early.
