SNOW TOP MOUNTAIN unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. HIT IT RICH tracked the pace, eased outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to gain slim lead inside the sixteenth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. GOLD D'ORO rated off the pace after breaking slowly, saved ground to nearing the top of the stretch, angled out and finished willingly for the show. SPEAK EASY GAL set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged in the stretch, maintained a slim advantage to inside the sixteenth pole, then gave way. DENOMINATION outrun early, angled out widest of all for room in the stretch and closed with a belated rally. THUNDERING EMILIA stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied when boxed in behind SPEAK EASY GAL in the stretch and failed to recover. PERSUADING prompted the pace outside SPEAK EASY GAL to past the eighth pole and weakened. HEAVENLY LANDING reserved off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive.
