THE ISSUE IS POWER reserved along the inside, angled outside the leader for the stretch run and rallied to draw clear late under pressure. SUMMER LUCKY settled off the pace, steadied in traffic on the far turn, angled three wide at the top of the stretch and rallied for the place. MICHAEL IVAR set the pace along the rail, edged clear on the far turn, then weakened late. LONG WAR raced five wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. HEFTY GROOM hit the gate at the start and was not a factor. WASATCH lacked a late response. TROY'S PLAY stalked the pace into the far turn and gave way. CLOUD COVER chased the pace, made a run at the leader four wide on the far turn and stopped.
