NOSTALGIC bumped at the start, stalked the pace, moved to gain command leaving the turn and drew clear under a strong hand ride. BRASSAPASS bumped with NOSTALGIC at the start, set the pace along the inside and held the place while no match for the winner. STAR OF RAJAB outrun early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied for the show. OIL CITY well placed racing along the rail, tired. DESTRUCTION wearing a nasal strip, advanced three wide on the turn to reach the leaders, then gave way. COLUMBIA GORGE failed to menace. SIR ANDREW J. wearing a nasal strip, saved ground to no avail. ETHICAL ACTIONS showed early speed and faltered. WAYCROSS CITY was not a factor. JANTZER raced five wide around the turn while outrun. SASHA'S PROSPECT wearing a nasal strip, was in striking position on the turn, then faded. ARKON (CHI) showed little.
