PAULA SMITH set the pace along the rail, drew clear racing down the backstretch, then responded when set down for the drive and held sway. DUCHESS COUNTY reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn and rallied to gain the place. ROYAL DOVE unhurried after being steadied at the start, angled out for the drive and rallied to be up for the show. MINNY'S NIECE chased the pace along the inside into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. HONORABLE CAT chased the winner into the stretch and weakened. PEACE PLEDGE allowed to settle, saved ground and lacked a late response. KABEEB steadied in the early going and was not a factor. GROOM'S KISS was outrun. HONOR BESTOWED raced in striking position into the far turn and faltered. OPTIMIZE tracked the pace three wide to nearing the stretch and faded.
