Footnotes

SONGFEST showed speed along the inside, drew clear in early stretch and remained clear to the wire under pressure. TITIAN TIME reserved along the rail after breaking slowly, rallied through the stretch to be up for the place. TROPICAL SNOW (SAF) chased the pace into the stretch and closed with a mild response while just being edged for the place. PIMENTINHA rated off the pace, angled out for the drive and didn't do enough late. MILITARY LASS prompted the pace outside SONGFEST, then tired in the drive. AROARABLE off slowly, was outrun early, then gained some ground without threatening. WISE AND PRECIOUS showed early foot along the rail and faltered. UNHURRIED failed to menace. MASTER CON ARTIST chased the pace three wide around the turn and faded. DEFINED BORDERS was not a factor.
