Footnotes

SEASTATE rated close about the three path, moved alongside Ode To Revolution into the final turn, dueled with a slim advantage from the head of the lane and lasted well under a steady drive. MOTION PLAY rated off the pace in the four path, bid into the final turn, closed to the winners poll in deep stretch but ultimately outfinished. SEISMIC FORCE lacked room on the rail into the opening turn, settled back inside through the backstretch, was boxed in through the final turn, bid on the rail entering the stretch and finished well. ODE TO REVOLUTION rated the pace inside through the backstretch, contested toward the quarter pole, loomed a solid threat through most of the stretch then weakened nearing the wire. AQAB, in tight the opening turn, settled back early, closed

five wide on the final turn then finished evenly. PEACEFUL RUSSIAN, unhurried off the rail, bid in the three path of the final turn and finished well. FIND THE WIRE, unhurried toward mid track, eased out for the drive and finished evenly. NICKEL PICKLE was outrun. HARBOR RIDGE had a short early lead inside the opening turn, dropped from the front entering the backstretch, maintained a close presence to the quarter pole then weakened with a furlong to go. SAMMY'S TOY rated close to the pace inside then faded through the lane. HOWDYAMISSTHISONE rated off the pace while off the rail then faded on the final turn. FABULOUS TEXAS never factored.
