BATTER UP rated off the pace, angled in and rallied along the rail to gain the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and was fully extended to prevail. HULAKO stalked the pace, rallied to gain a slim lead nearing the eighth pole and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. DOVER BEACH allowed to settle after being steadied when bumped at the start, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then finished willingly while being outgamed to the wire by the top ones. SOLD THE FARM reserved early, angled four wide on the far turn, then closed well to just miss the show. DRAMON bumped DOVER BEACH at the start, chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead racing into the stretch, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. RIVER LEMON outrun while saving ground, swung out for the stretch run and gained some ground. TOP SURPRIZE unhurried after breaking

poorly, saved ground, swung wide for the stretch run and passed tired rivals without threatening. TOMHANNOCK failed to menace. INAGOTABLE rated off the pace after drifting out on the first turn, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. GUDAHI set the pace along the rail to the quarter pole, then faltered. HURRICANE CAUSEWAY tracked the pace along the rail into the far turn and faded. WISE WAGER was outrun after hesitating at the start.
