Footnotes

NERGAL (FR) reserved off the pace, saved ground while advancing around the far turn, eased outside GAELIC STORM in the stretch and rallied to be up late. GAELIC STORM set the pace under pressure along the rail, opened a clear lead in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner late. FEELS ALL RIGHT (IRE) rated off the pace, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be just up for the show. TASTEFULLY SMART up close early, eased back off the leaders racing down the backstretch, swung out for the stretch run and closed with FEELS ALL RIGHT to just miss the show. COZY LION outrun after being steadied at the start, steadied again at the top of the stretch, angled wide for room and closed ground late. COACH GRAVY stalked the pace along the

inside, swung out for the stretch run and gave way. GUADALCANAL failed to menace. FOLLIA moved up on the backstretch to press the pace outside GAELIC STORM into the stretch, then tired. MINT MAKER unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and had no late response. SURELY SENT was no factor while saving ground. INTERCOASTAL moved up with FOLLIA on the backstretch to press the pace three wide around the far turn and into the stretch, then faltered. EXCELLENT SOLDIER was outrun.
