STRASBOURG stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run, then rallied to be just up at the wire. PAX chased the pace three wide, moved to take over midway of the turn and opened a clear lead, then just failed to last. UNITED STATES unhurried early, raced five wide around the turn and closed well for the show. CRACK THEPAT set the pace under pressure along the rail to midway of the turn, then gave way. YA GOTTA HAVE SOUL stalked the paced three wide around the turn and tired. MR. MARKET pressed the pace outside CRACK THEPAT to midway of the turn, then had nothing left. AUDEAMUS stalked the pace along the rail to midway of the turn and faltered. GOLD STRIKE BEGINS off slowly, moved up to track the pace four wide, then faded leaving the turn.
