CHAYSEN' ALEX rated off the pace, was forced to wait for room in behind rivals on the far turn, angled out and rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew away. CURIOUS TIGER stalked the pace three wide, rallied to take over leaving the far turn, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. GRAND STAGE allowed to settle, saved ground into the stretch, eased out and closed to be up for the show. DECAF AGAIN outrun early, swung wide for the stretch run and gained some ground without threatening. SIR RABBIT reserved off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. SERAPI CAT unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and failed to menace while improving his position. CASH US NOW taken in hand early, swung out for the stretch run and never threatened. USAIN AGAIN reserved early, steadied in traffic in the stretch and was not a factor. ROMAN SILVER broke awkwardly, raced four wide around the far turn and faltered. CONCERTOS SONG set the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. HOT REWARD tracked the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn, then faded. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND chased the pace after being steadied in behind CONCERTOS SONG in the run to the first turn, moved up on the backstretch to try that rival into the far turn, then dropped back.
