Footnotes

BOZIQUE attended the pace in hand, split horses to make his bid, drew even entering the stretch and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. DIAMONDESQUE rushed up along the inside, fought on through a prolonged drive but wasn't quite good enough. CLASSY AND SERENE contended four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. STACEY'S COMPRISE was allowed to settle, came four wide and

improved position through the lane. BIRD IN THE BUSH was allowed to settle, angled out four wide entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. BLONDIE JO was jostled at the start, settled into stride between horses and went evenly. CHAPEL'S BEAUTY was forwardly placed along the inside through the turn and tired. MISS GUCHI failed to respond. CAPTIVA'S CALLING disputed pace four wide, but drifted out leaving the turn and dropped out. FIVE LILLY broke slowly and was never a factor. LIBRA FOUR was bumped at the start and showed little. VELVET HALO was always outrun, eased to the wire but walked off.
