Footnotes

REFLEJO broke sharply, tucked in to set the pace, shook off SHERIFF IRA on the second turn, widened into the stretch and held safely. SHERIFF IRA prompted the pace three wide, was unable to match strides with the winner on the second turn, but stayed on fairly well to prove second best. SLAMMIN' SLEW was close up three wide, flattened entering the stretch but had enough left to safely hold the show. CARY STREET was allowed to settle, made a middle move five wide, offered a mild bid leaving the second turn but failed to sustain the drive. STRONG FIRE pulled early, settled under a snug hold, closed the gap some through the second turn, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. DIAMOND SHOWCASE contended between horses for five furlongs and retreated. CONGRATS CRIMINAL was jostled at the start, settled three wide and failed to respond. UNO AGAIN was bumped at the start and slow into stride, and passed only the tiring ones. EL COBRE failed to respond. BE MY FRANKENSTEIN was bumped at the start and showed little thereafter. CIRCULARITY tucked in to save ground while never far back, stopped after five furlongs, eased to the wire but walked off.
