### Footnotes

SPUN CAP stalked the pace in hand three wide, launched her bid entering the stretch, quickened under left handed urging inside the furlong maker, overtook the dueling leaders inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear in the final yards. SLEW'S EXCHANGE vied for the lead three wide, drifted out further leaving the turn, battled on well but was unable to resist the winner. MY DUE PROCESS disputed the pace along the inside, cut the corner and inched away briefly, was collared again with three-sixteenths to run, weakened slightly during the drive and settled for the show. HURRICANE GIRL was allowed to settle, circled five wide to make a mild bid but lacked a response when called upon. REVENUE was slow early and unhurried into stride, swung to the outside leaving the turn but was never a factor. THE RAHY ANGEL contended along the inside through the turn and tired.
