ANOTHER chased the winner into the stretch, was outmoved by that rival in midstretch, then was gaining slowly at the finish. DREAM SUPREME chased the leaders three wide around the turn, dropped back in midstretch, then gained some ground late while never a threat. FRENCH MADAM reserved in striking position into the stretch, lacked a late response. KATZ ME IF YOU CAN bobbled soon after the start and was never a factor. SILVER CHELE was outrun while saving ground.
