SWINGFORTHEFENCES rated off the pace, altered course at the top of the stretch to get outside a wall of horses, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew away under urging. SHANIKO reserved early, angled four wide on the far turn, rallied to gain a slim lead approaching the eighth pole but was no match for the winner. CAPIAS chased the pace off the rail, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. PIES PROSPECT unhurried early, circled rivals five wide on the far turn to reach near even terms for command at the top of the stretch, then tired. SUAVE tracked the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. HOCKEY JOCK unhurried early, steadied to avoid running up on rivals on the far turn and failed to threaten. BRIDE'S BEST BOY chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then faded in the drive. CERVELO saved ground and was done early. CURRENT NINER raced four wide and was through after six furlongs. INDIAN GAME showed little. PLAYHURT showed speed along the inside into the far turn and stopped.
