**Footnotes**

B. B. BEST stalked the pace two deep after a brief early lead, resumed control approaching the five sixteenths pole, moved clear toward the quarter pole and held well with steady handling. AIR LORD rated off the pace about the three path, started his drive into the turn, had aim entering the stretch and finished well clear for place while chasing the winner home. MR. UNSTOPPABLE, unhurried inside, angled five wide past the quarter pole and finished evenly outside. A. P. EDDIE chased the pace from the inside, lacked a response on the rail through the turn, angled four wide for the drive and faltered from there. NEXT ADVENTURE rated off the pace and off the rail then weakened through the lane. BROTHER JOEY rated a short lead inside, was pressured on the rail through the turn then weakened in the stretch. CAIXA ELETRONICA never factored. HIGH BRASS gave chase while off the rail and weakened on the turn. NATHAN RIDGE never factored. VOORHEE'S BALLAD broke down near the three eighths pole. The stewards posted the inquiry before declaring this race official.
