By subscription of \$150 each by Saturday, January 31, 2009, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$150,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$90,000; \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to sixth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a grade/group I or II sweepstakes allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstakes 4 lbs., of \$30,000 in 2008/2009 6 lbs., of two races other than maiden or claiming in 2008/2009 8 lbs. Supplemental nominations may be made on Wednesday, February 11, 2009 at a fee of \$6,000, which includes entry and starting fees. HOW'S YOUR HALO rated close off the rail, started his drive leaving the turn, moved alongside the runner-up a few yards from the wire and edged ahead the final strides. IKIGAI, firmly rated to set the pace inside, was pressured for more into the lane, briefly matched strides with the winner in deep stretch though yielded the closing strides. BOLD START rated off the pace about the three path, entered the stretch three wide and finished evenly. TALE OF EKATI settled off the pace outside after an awkward break, gave chase three wide on the turn then finished evenly. LING LING QI showed no speed off the rail, bid into the turn but leveled off the final furlong. NOW A VICTOR was kept within range through the backstretch but showed insufficient response on the turn.
