KEY WEST APPEAL stalked the pace, took over command on the turn, drew clear under pressure, then was all out to prevail. IDEALIST, unhurried early, rallied between horses and was up for the place. PLATINUM LAKE allowed to settle early, angled to the outside leaving the turn and closed willingly. HALO'S BIG LIL, four wide around the turn, had no rally. CLEVER GLORY, squeezed back at the start, improved her position. PAM'S GOLD sprinted clear, angled over to the inside and gave way after losing the lead. FIFTY DEGREES well placed early, tired. PURA RAZA was no factor after being bumped hard at the start. FROZEN GEMS hustled up the inside to reach contention, then faltered. TROPICAL RAINBOW, up close after being bumped at the start, faded. ALONE IN FRONT, bumped hard at the start, was outrun. ETARIA faded while saving ground.
