CAT CAY outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. RAGING FEVER vied for the lead racing off the rail, drew clear on the turn and just failed to last. VAGUE MEMORY raced with the pace three wide into the turn, remained in contention into the stretch but couldn't gain late. CELTIC MELODY chased the pace into the stretch and lacked a late response. IRISH FANTASY bobbled at the start and failed to menace. SUPERDUPER MISS was outrun while racing three wide. TUGGER vied for the lead along the inside into the turn and faded.
