TRUST N LUCK outran MIDWAY CAT to the first turn, moved to the inside after clearing that rival, was well handled while making the pace along the inside into the stretch, then drew away when set down for the drive. SUPAH BLITZ reserved racing along the rail, advanced to loom a threat leaving the far turn, then was no match for the winner while gaining the place. MIDWAY CAT was steadied and angled outside the leader soon after entering the first turn, chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. OFFLEE WILD reserved off the pace, raced in striking position four wide around the far turn, then had no response when set down for the drive. WHYWHYWHY chased the leaders three wide, made a run to loom a threat entering the stretch, then faltered. TEN CENTS A SHINE was never a factor. CONSERVATION raced four wide throughout while being outrun. OZZIE CAT saved ground into the far turn and faded.
