FRENCHGLEN chased the pace, moved to take over from PREACH IT leaving the turn, then drew away under a strong hand ride. PREACH IT showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while saving the place. MAMBO BELL reserved early, raced three wide on the turn and closed to gain the show. MISS ELUSIVE moved up to chase the leaders three wide around the turn, then tired in the drive. FIRST MOVE well placed around the turn, faltered in the stretch run. ARTAX DANCER showed early foot along the inside and gave way. SUMMER FLASH was outrun. HOW ABOUT DATTT off slowly, saved ground and failed to be a factor. ELUSIVE SMILE failed to menace. SAZERAC SONG showed little after breaking slowly. SOLAR SONG raced four wide and trailed.
