SARAH AND ME showed speed along the inside to the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while holding the place. BOOGIE WOOGIE tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. LADY CHARLIE rated off the pace after breaking slowly, lacked a late response. LADY LAURIE SNOW was outrun. CANE CANDY stumbled at the start, chased the pace to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. WICKEDODOLOGY was not a factor. CHANG off slowly, was outrun. CHANCE REVIEW bobbled at the start, chased the pace along the inside into the turn, then faded.
