Footnotes

BALETTI rated off the pace, advanced into contention four wide around the far turn, then rallied to be up late. CARSON HALL reserved off the pace after being steadied in the run to the first turn, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to be up for the place. SUYETA chased the pace, made a run to

engage BIG PUSH on the far turn, then wore that rival down late to be up for the show while being outfinished by the top ones. BIG PUSH set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by SUYETA on the far turn, maintained a slim advantage to deep stretch and gave way. STRIKE AGAIN stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch and couldn't gain late. LEMON CREAM PIE was caught in tight racing into the first turn, stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and didn't do enough late. PENNINGTON chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then weakened. PREMIUM GOLD allowed to settle after breaking slowly, raced four wide around the far turn and closed ground late. SLAMBINO off slowly, saved ground and failed to menace. TAQARUB stalked the pace between rivals into the stretch and tired. ALEZZANDRO steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and was never a threat. HIS GREATNESS checked in the early going and rank on the first turn, was not a factor.
