WILDCAT QUEEN vied for the lead along the rail, responded when challenged by CHAYA midway of the turn and was fully extended to prevail after a prolonged duel. CHAYA chased the pace three wide, moved up on the turn to vie for the lead, then dueled with WILDCAT QUEEN to deep stretch and was outgamed to the wire. NEVADA MISS rated off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and closed to gain the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. HONORABLE GAL reserved early, advanced four wide on the turn to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. UNREPENTANT outrun early, raced three wide on the turn and improved his position while never a threat. BROAD HOPES well placed while saving ground, faltered in the drive. NICE KIPPER vied for the lead outside WILDCAT QUEEN to nearing the stretch and faded. UNCORK showed little. VALUE ORIENTED was outrun after breaking slowly.
