HIGHWAY PROSPECTOR unhurried after breaking slowly, angled to the inside in early stretch and rallied along the rail to be up late. HARMONY HALL chased the pace, moved up to reach even terms for command on the turn, vied for the lead to deep stretch and was outfinished. HERE'S ZEALOUS chased the pace three wide, moved up to vie for the lead outside HARMONY HALL through the stretch and was edged for the place while unable to match strides with the winner late. DAVIDS EXPECTATION showed speed along the inside, came off the rail for the stretch run and weakened. BET ON JOE chased the leaders five wide around the turn and tired. JEANIES ROB chased the leaders four wide into the stretch and faltered. PAGING failed to menace. TICKET TO FREEDOM off slowly, was outrun. FRAZEE'S FOLLY was never a factor. HANDSOME SMILE rated in striking position off the pace, faded in the drive.
