Footnotes

EMOLLIENT was rank to place, tugged to contention along the inside, was hemmed in midway through the second turn, worked her way to the outside leaving the quarter pole, reeled in MAJESTIC RIVER and was up in the final yards. The latter was away in good order, set the pace off of the inside, fought on diligently through a long drive but grudgingly gave way late. WATRUGONNADOROSIE was in tight and steadied entering the first turn, settled into stride removed from the rail, launched a sweeping move four wide on the second turn, was floated out further leaving the quarter pole when her stable mate EMOLLIENT came out, flattened during the drive and settled for the minor award. SWINGER'S PARTY was close up four wide, but faltered between horses after six furlongs and faded. MISS SQUEAL contended between horses through the second turn and retreated. NUMBER ONE DANCER trailed.
