ABRAHAM disputed the pace toward the inside, edged clear leaving the second turn, veered out near the furlong marker, was straightened away and held sway. THE CANDIDATE was allowed to settle, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, advanced between rivals on the second turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, kicked on well and was making up ground. TRADE RUMOR contended between horses, tipped out four wide entering the stretch, loomed a threat but flattened during the drive. SQUADRON A vied for the lead three wide, contested the issue through the second turn, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. SUCCESSFUL BROTHERS was within contention along the inside early, then between horses to the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. TWINING HEARTS chased four wide for six furlongs and retreated. RIGHT RIGHT broke slow, tucked in to save ground, but was never a factor.
