Footnotes

COOL BLUE RED HOT settled in hand, between horses, tipped out nearing the furlong marker, quickened once uncovered and wore down FINALE in the final yards. FINALE broke a step slow, moved into contention five wide, ranged up to engage the leaders leaving the second turn, kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. BAD DEBT prompted the pace between horses, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. MONUMENT HILL was forwardly placed along the inside, launched his bid between horses, forged command entering the stretch, but flattened in the drive. STAR CHANNEL opened clear and angled in to set the pace, came up empty leaving the second turn and faded. ABILIO was close up four wide, but weakened between horses after six furlongs and retreated. LIL BIT O'FUN was allowed to settle, got through and improved position. TEMERAINE saved ground to little avail. QUICK WIT settled in the second flight, was never a factor, was unsaddled on the backstretch following the race and was vanned off.
