CRYSTAL SYMPHONY, unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied through the drive be up in the final strides. GRAND VERANDA, well placed in behind the leaders, lacked room on the far turn and in early stretch, split rivals and finished well to just miss. TRES CORONAS vied for the lead along the inside, edged clear in midstretch, then weakened late. SEJM'S LUNAR STAR saved ground and improved her position. LADY BUCKINGHAM made a bid at the leaders three wide on the far turn and tired. COZZENE'SAFFAIR was no factor after bumping with TOCAR at the start. RUM PUNCH lacked a rally. MELODRAMACTIC vied for the lead around the far turn and faded. TOCAR, bumped at the start, was through after a half mile.
