REGAL COUNTESS made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then increased her margin to the wire under urging. VERY EARLY SCOTCH stalked the winner into the stretch, then couldn't stay with that rival while clearly second best. MOON BIRD rated off the pace, angled out on the far turn and gained the show. MONTEGO LIGHT well placed racing off the rail, tired in the drive. LORRAINE was outrun after she broke in the air. FAFNIR stalked the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. JILL'S ZI ZI was never a factor. IMA HALO turned in a dull effort.
