NOT FOR MONEY reserved off the pace, angled outside the leaders entering the stretch, rallied to gain the lead approaching the sixteenth pole, then drew clear. YES MASTER vied for the lead three wide to inside the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while edging GSTAAD for the place. The latter, vied for the lead between horses around the turn, continued to contest the pace with YES MASTER to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. HE'S SO CHIC vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch and tired. DAY PASS clipped heels leaving the chute, tracked the pace, angled four wide on the turn for racing room and faltered. LOCAL CELEBRITY showed early foot along the rail and faded. FOLK FESTIVAL (GB) was outrun. LIGER trailed.
