JOES BLAZING AARON quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the rail, drew clear in midstretch, then was all out to hold off DUKE OF DOOM. The latter, stalked the pace along the inside, eased out in the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. BLUEGRASS JET reserved off the pace, closed with a mild response to gain the show. SUMMER IN GIZA chased the winner to nearing the stretch, then tired. YANKEE KITTEN allowed to settle

after bumping with VOCE DEL LEONE at the start, was improving his position when steadied in traffic late. YUKI off slowly, failed to menace. IMPERSONATOR chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. MADNESS N' MAYHEM was no factor while racing four wide. MANCHURIAN HIGH off slowly, was no threat while racing three wide. HALO'S THUNDER was outrun after breaking slowly. VOCE DEL LEONE showed little after being checked when he bumped with YANKEE KITTEN at the start. DREAM OF SIDNEY rated off the pace, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
