SITUATIONAL ETHICS raced off the pace inside, advanced along the rail on the far turn, angled out turning for home, rallied four wide and kicked clear. FORTUNATE BILL bobbled at the break, raced off the pace inside, angled out entering the stretch, rallied three wide and came up second best. JARDUN raced close up inside, bid two wide midway on the turn and was outfinished. SOUP A' FLEET set the pace and stayed on well to the end. IN THE

MIDNIGHT raced three wide early, three wide on the far turn, four wide into the lane and had no rally. SUPERIORITY was bumped at the start, stalked three wide and tired. BAD BOY BURNIE raced off the pace, made a four wide run on the far turn and flattened out. WASN'T ME did not factor. DYNAFORMERSDIAMOND was off a bit slow, came three wide into the lane and was outrun. ROYAL DISTINCTION was bumped at the start, raced three wide early and faded. RUN WILKO RUN raced close up early, was steadied between rivals on the first turn and faded. PRETTY ROWDY stalked, gave way, was eased in the stretch and walked off.
