Footnotes

READYSHAKEGO hesitated at the start to get away well behind his field, commenced a long drive between horses, steadied inside the quarter pole, angled out leaving the second turn, steadied again near the three-sixteenths pole, shifted out further to be clear, kicked on well and was up in the final strides. IL VOLO attended the pace along the inside, angled out entering the stretch, loomed large but was unable to resist the winner. PRESTIGE WORLDWIDE set the pressured pace, fought on through a prolonged drive but grudgingly gave way. GRAYBIGNBADLIKEDAD settled saving ground, got through and was making up ground. REY ROCKET prompted the pace two wide, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. SHENANDOAH BOUND settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and finished with a belated gain. SOUTHSIDE JOHNNY passed only the tiring ones. BRAT was rank to place, rushed up five wide through the first turn, came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. LASTING IMPACT failed to respond. ARCH PISTOL contended four wide to the second turn and dropped out. CRUISES CREEK set the pressured pace three wide to the second turn and faltered. MUSIC KING was outrun.
