Footnotes

MANUKA HONEY attended the pace toward the inside, angled out to be clear midway through the turn, came four wide to make her bid, and was fully extended to wear down IROQUOIS GIRL in the final strides. IROQUOIS GIRL tracked the dueling leaders three wide, commenced a long drive with seven-sixteenths to run, forged command leaving the turn, cut the corner entering the stretch, edged clear and fought on but was denied in the last jump. DEFOE STREET lunged and was bumped at the start, shifted out five wide to be clear, finished with some late run and was along for the show. MAGNOLIA LANE was allowed to settle, came four wide but lacked a response when called upon. GUNNER GAL passed the tiring ones. CAPPACHINO GAL was away alertly, dueled for the lead along the inside through the turn and retreated. MAKE IT ANYWHERE broke inward and bumped with DEFOE STREET, settled saving ground, steadied off of the tiring OLYMPIC AVENUE near the three-sixteenths pole and was never a factor. OLYMPIC AVENUE dueled for the lead two wide for a half and stopped.
