**Footnotes**

LITTLE B ROSSON rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn, rallied to gain the lead inside the eighth pole, then edged away. SOLDIER GIRL was caught in tight at the start, tracked the pace three wide around the far turn, then closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. SPIRIT LINE set the pace along the rail, responded when headed by GRANTED TIGER on the far turn, dueled with that rival to inside the eighth pole, then gave way. GRANTED TIGER chased the pace, made a run to gain a slim lead on the far turn, dueled with SPIRIT LINE to inside the eighth pole and weakened. DOUBLE DINGHY DAY reserved racing along the rail, advanced to loom a threat in the stretch but was blocked in behind the leaders through the final sixteenth and couldn't threaten. RED HOT BULLET stalked the pace along the inside, was steadied soon after entering the backstretch to avoid running up on the leader, remained in contention into the stretch, then checked from tight quarters and tired. SWEET EXCHANGE stalked the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and faltered.
