Footnotes

SKY MASTERSON was forwardly placed along the inside, tipped out four wide, split horses and wore down his rivals late. FARMERS MARKET was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, angled out five wide leaving the second turn and was making up ground. SATURDAY'S FOR FUN was close up three deep, came four wide and stayed on well through a long drive. SOLICITATION set the pressured pace, weakened slightly during the drive and

grudgingly gave way. DR. GOLDFARB prompted the pace three wide, forged command leaving the second turn, edged clear but flattened in the drive. BENERGY was slow into stride, was unhurried off of the inside, swung wide entering the stretch but failed to seriously threaten. JIVE ON was slow early, settled toward the inside, angled out seven wide but found his best stride too late. DADDY LIKES THAT contended between horses, angled out entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. ROARS MORE settled saving ground, got through to make his bid, was blocked late, steadied and lost all chance. FRANKLINPARK went wide and failed to respond. PACMANSTEPHEN was through early. GIACOMO THE GREAT (VEN) chased four wide to the second turn and stopped.
