SANDY GATOR set the pace along the inside and held the place while being outfinished by the winner. BURSTING FORTH, allowed to settle, raced four wide on the far turn but couldn't gain late. BARN SWALLOW, unhurried after being steadied early, lacked a rally. NATALIE TOO, off poorly, moved up quickly to prompt the pace into the far turn and tired. MEMORY CALL was no threat while five wide on the far turn. MISSY DEAR chased the pace while saving ground and faltered. SWING TO THE BEAT trailed.
