HIGH YIELD outran HAL'S HOPE for the lead around the first turn, responded when challenged by that rival again approaching the end of the backstretch and drew off through the stretch under a strong hand ride. HAL'S HOPE bumped at the start, stalked the pace after being outrun for the lead, moved to challenge HIGH YIELD racing around the far turn but couldn't stay with that rival while proving second best. ELITE MERCEDES was forced out behind PERSONAL FIRST racing into the first turn, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. GREENWOOD LAKE far back early, saved ground into the stretch, angled out and closed willingly. AMERICAN BULLET bumped at the start, was reserved into the far turn, advanced into striking position entering the stretch, then lacked the needed late response. UN FINO VINO checked racing into the first turn forcing out PERSONAL FIRST, raced in striking position three wide around the far turn and failed to rally. DEPUTY WARLOCK allowed to settle, angled wide for the stretch run and failed to menace. POLISH MINER reserved early, angled wide in early stretch and failed to threaten. RUPERT HERD was no factor after being squeezed back at the start. BEN THE MAN chased the pace along the rail into the far turn and faded. PERSONAL FIRST bumped at the start, was forced out and steadied on the first turn, then was through after a half mile.
