MELODY OF COLORS showed speed outside YACHT TO PAY FOR, shook off a challenge from STORM DANCER leaving the turn, then drew clear through the stretch under a strong hand ride. HEATHER LIGHT unhurried early, rallied along the inside to be up for the place. NOT IN ORDER tracked the pace off the rail into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. MOM'S APPEAL unhurried after breaking slowly, gained ground late to just miss the show. STORM DANCER chased the pace three wide, made a run to reach near even terms for command leaving the turn, then weakened in the drive. SEVERUS failed to menace. YACHT TO PAY FOR showed brief speed along the rail and tired. DIABLO'S PEAK up close early, raced three wide on the turn and faltered.
