Footnotes

GRAT unhurried early, was steadied in behind SILVER PLATA on the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and closed fast to be just up in the final yards. MOUNTAIN MAMBO tracked the pace, rallied to gain a brief lead in deep stretch but was edged to the wire in the final strides. BAENA reserved early, rushed up along the outside down the backstretch to gain a slim lead entering the far turn, opened a clear advantage in the stretch, then gave way late. SILVER PLATA rated off the pace, angled three wide on the far turn and closed with a mild rally. CLASSY CHARM vied for the lead outside GENTLE BREEZE, continued to contest the pace with BAENA around the far turn, then weakened in the drive. TIGER BELLE outrun early, saved ground and failed to menace. GENTLE BREEZE stumbled at the start, vied for the lead along the rail to the far turn and tired. CAPISTRANO chased the pace for a half mile and faltered. COMEONGAL showed early foot and faded. (The rail on the turf course was set at 60 feet).
