Footnotes

MINISTER'S JOY dropped well back early, was unhurried for six furlongs, rallied along the rail on the turn, angled out at the three-sixteenths pole then unleashed a strong late run to get up in the final strides. JET PROPULSION set the pace along the inside to the turn, maintained a clear advantage into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. ELECTRIC LIGHT chased three wide to he turn, lodged a bid in upper stretch and held well for a share. COSMIC KRIS raced in good position between horses for six furlongs and finished evenly. TISSY FIT raced just off the pace along the rail, angled out on the turn and lacked a late response. SEASIDE RETREAT raced evenly while three wide. GOTTTCHA GOLD chased in the two path into upper stretch and tired. PULPIT TALK raced four wide to the turn and gave way.
