ASSET set a pressured pace on the inside, responded when roused and sprinted away in upper stretch. AZTEC RUN raced three wide off the pace, angled in at the top of the lane and finished well inside. SUPREME SERENE hopped at the start, raced close up inside, angled out and rallied mildly. PAPAW BODIE was outrun early, came wide and finished well outside. BROKE BY NOON raced between foes, then chased inside and tired. MORT'S LEGACY was off a bit slow and gained some ground between rivals late. TEN BELLS pressed the pace and tired. BALTIMORE SAINT raced four wide early, stalked three wide, loomed boldly on the far turn and tired. QUEEN'S KNIGHT saved ground and lacked a rally. KINTLA'S FOLLY stalked two wide and tired. PARKINSON FIELD raced three wide and faded. LOS VICTORS did not factor.
