LACONIC tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up at the wire. MODEST set the pace along the rail, edged clear in the stretch, then just failed to last. PRADO DASH reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to be up for the show. IVY CONNECTION rated off the pace, saved ground and closed with a mild response. GOLD TRADER allowed to settle, saved ground to nearing the stretch, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. PUNSTER chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. MAPLE LEAF KITTEN outrun early, steadied at the top of the stretch and never threatened. DYNAMITE DUDE failed to menace. UNCLE JOE tracked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch, then tired. PERFECT JOISKI was not a factor. KEEP ME POSTED chased the pace into the far turn and faded.
